

**Annual Report

We began with a social hour at 5:45 P. M. followed by a full course chicken buffet dinner catered by Chicken Manor, Kent, Ohio.

The tables were decorated in blue and gold and spring silk flowers for all. The arrangement committee chaired by Mary Diese Burton provided the decorations.

President LaDema Youngen Gatten (1938) welcomed the Alumni and their guests.

First Vice President Richard N. Wood(1948) gave the invocation.

After dinner and a brief intermission we moved to the Les Bennett room for our meeting and program.

The Treasurer's Books were audited by R. E. Crislip (1948) and were found to be accurate and in order.

Principal George J. Steyer reported on the school system.

The graduating class of 1991 had 177 graduate. Many will be going on to further their education and some will join the work force and some will be going into the service.

Local scholarships made available to students by business organizations and trusts totaled \$24,000.00.

Some of the other things that took place at Tallmadge this past year - A video tape was made and sent with packages to Saudi Arabia.

Speech and Hearing Program now staffed with two full time teachers.

The Fall play presented was "Alice in Wonderland" and the Spring play was "Grease".

Grades 4 through 8 participated in the California Achievement Test and tested above average.

This was the first year for the ninth grade to take the Proficiency Test.

Tallmadge Rotary Club planted trees at Munroe Elementary School.

Thirty-five students are participating in the Summer Project.

Tallmadge is now in the Suburban League and had many athletic achievements this year.

Odessey of Mind Teams were in regional competition.

Music students competed at Kent State.

Business Professional students placed well in contest.

We had our Fine Arts Festival and the Cheerleaders were in National Competition at Jacksonville, Florida.

160 Awards were given at the annual awards program - 2 Seniors received the Chrysler Awards.

We updated our bus fleet this year - we put three levies on the ballot this spring and two were passed.

The school system had many successes in academics, athletics and extracurricular activiites.

In 1943 Mr. Eugene Smith joined the teaching staff as principal. That was when Mr. McCobb became Superintendant.

Mr. Smith coached the football team and the basketball team through a tough schedule in the fall of 1945. The football team was tied for Summit County Championship and the basketball team was Summit County Champion. He continued as Principal through 1948-1949. We couldn't hold him. He left at the close of the 1948-1949 year and went to Wooster.

Eugene Smith died Nov. 17, 1990 at the age of 88 years.
