Approximately 217 Alumni, guests and former Teachers met at Tallmadge High School Saturday June 12, 1993 for the 114th annual banquet and meeting.

We began with a social hour at 5:45 P. M. followed by a chicken and beef buffet dinner served by Mel's Catering of Kent, Ohio.

The decorations were blue and gold with gold silk flowers for all. The arrangement committee chaired by Faith Wagner Hause (1943) provided the decorations.

President Richard N. Wood (1948) welcomed the Alumni and their guests.

Rev. Mullins husband of 50 year graduate Juanita Sanford Mullins gave the invocation.

After dinner and a brief intermission we moved to the Les Bennett room for our meeting and program.

President Wood called the meeting to order at 7:30 P. M.

Superintendent of Schools Dennis R. Buzzelli gave a report of the school system.

On June 6, 1993, 153 seniors were graduated from Tallmadge High School. 78% will be attending a 4 year College, 8% a 2 year college, 3% a Trade or Technical Program, 3% enter the Military and 8% enter the labor market.

Extra Curricular Activities:

Academic Challenge Team - In a tournament of twelve county area schools Tallmadge placed 10th.

The Fine Arts Festival awarded nearly 100 ribbons for excellence. Among the many fine projects were model house frames, clock, coatracks mass produced Tallmadge Twister Tops, castings, metal works of art and technical drawings.

Vocal Music-The Choir and Choraliers performed at the Holiday Tree Festival at the Summit Mall, Tallmadge Historical Society Christmas Open House, The Tallmadge Library Open House, Lions Club Dinner, Winter Concert, Fine Arts Festival and Weaver School. Several members competed at the Ohio Music Educator Solo and Ensemble Contest at Nordonia in February. They also made a district tour in December.

Drama Productions - "up The Down Staircase" and "South Pacific" Our participation in the Fine Arts Festival was enlarged this year. A mime troupe has been started which has already performed before audiences.

Marching Band- received excellent ratings at Louisville, Norton and Brunswick Band Competitions. The band performed at Kent Roosevelt's Band Show, all football games and Homecoming, Little League and Memorial Day Parades.

Concert Band - held concerts in January March and April. Participated in the District VI Solo and Ensemble Contest at Nordonia and received 4 Superior and 3 Excellent ratings. They were rated Excellent at District VI Band and Chorus Competition at Copley and rated Excellent at the Showcase Music Festival at Kings Island.

Jazz Combo performed at the Fine Arts Festival and were exposed to jazz improvisation the major emphasis.

Tallmadge is a four-year comprehensive High School. There were 753 students in Grades 9-12 and 2,419 students in the district. The first class numbering eight graduated in 1879.

Class of 1943

The 50 year Class Report was presented by Donald Jones. The class of 1943 has been reunited this weekend for the first time since graduation, coming from Arizona, Florida, New York and Ohio - seven from Tallmadge.

We began the weekend with a western style barbecue at the Olde Town Hall on Friday evening. This was a super event with good food and the opportunity to renew old friendships. We will continue the festivities with a gathering for ~~brunch~~ at the Cuyahoga Falls Sheraton on Sunday.

In September 1931, 16 of the 41 that would later graduate as the Class of 1943 entered the first grade at Tallmadge. We were in two rooms as we would be for most of the following years. Mrs. Stamford and Miss Blanc were our teachers and we soon became "hooked on phonics". We were fortunate to have had these and many other excellent teachers during our school years. I will not attempt to name them all as some of the very deserving would be missed. I do wish to give recognition to former teachers who are with us tonight and thank them for coming.

They are: Margaret Acken Dunlavy - 6th Grade - Irma Saukkonen Simmerer - Home Ec; Arlene Stalder - Music; Donald Cordier - Shop and Basketball Coach Beatrice Hawkins - Math and Latin; Carrie Gruccio English and French; Dr. Gerald Reed - History.

We were disappointed to learn that Miss Louada Morgan, who had planned to be with us, is unable to be here. She recently fractured a bone in her leg and is now recuperating. We all wish her a speedy recovery.

Some of the things remembered from our school days are:

Trips to the Post Office to buy candy and school supplies.
The ringing of the school bell - too bad if you were not back from the post office when the second bell rang.
Class picnics at the end of the year when it always seemed to rain.
Bus rides to and particularly from, the basketball games.
Songs that had words.
Friday nights at the H & H.
Friendships that we enjoyed.

At the time that we graduated our Country was in the midst of World War II. This would change our lives forever. Within months each of the young men would volunteer or be called for military service and serve we did - in the army, the navy and the air force; in the European and Pacific theaters of operation and in the USA. It is very fortunate that all were able to return home. The young women would continue their education or support the war effort by working in the defense industry.

All of our class members have been accounted for except for Ray Shayler and Helen Schwerdtfeger. Six are deceased - Norris Crislip, Edwin Williamson and George Pierce who were with us from the first grade - Charles Willgoths and Bill Pletcher. We are pleased to have 32 of the remaining 34 here tonight.
